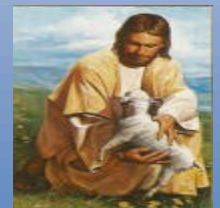

## About Today's Speaker. . .

Dr. J. Wayne Kilpatrick served as pulpit minister of the Homewood Church of Christ in Birmingham for 27 years. During that time the congregation experienced phenomenal growth, having increased its membership from 250 in 1973 to nearly 1500 at the time he left. During that time the contribution grew from \$1750 per week to a budget of \$42,000 per Sunday. The Homewood congregation increased its full time staff to 8 ministers. Homewood's campus and facilities are valued at 15 million dollars today. During his tenure with Homewood, a Christian Day School was begun, the Homewood Christian Counseling Center was opened, Victory Place Retirement Apartments and Victory Place Manor, and assisted living facility were all begun and were located on the property.

Kilpatrick attended Madison Academy, a Christian high school in Huntsville and then entered Freed-Hardeman College in Henderson, Tennessee. He holds the following degrees: B.A., B.S., M.S., M.R.E., M.Div, and in June of 1998 he earned the Doctor of Ministry degree. He is an alumnus of Freed-Hardeman University, Harding Graduate School of Religion, Alabama Christian School of Religion and Southern Christian University. Kilpatrick and his wife, the former Carolyn Keith, have two children and four grandchildren.

In July of 1999, Kilpatrick announced to the congregation that he would be transitioning out of the pulpit of Homewood in September of 2000. For many years he felt a calling to help strengthen churches throughout the brotherhood. From May of 2000 until January of 2004, he conducted seminars, revival, lectures, and did church consulting, traveling to many parts of the country.

In February of 2004, after having traveled for four years teaching and preaching God's Word, he decided to reenter local work and became the preaching minister for the Heritage Place Church of Christ in Irondale. The church had met for 22 years in the Jefferson Christian School building and was down to about 60 in Sunday morning attendance. In October of 2006, the church entered its very first church building and has now grown to nearly 200 in attendance. They are in the process of building a new fellowship hall and four additional classrooms. The church is served by five elders, and seven deacons.
